Word Relay

- **How to Play:** Divide students into teams. Each team lines up. The first student in each team is given an English word, and they must run to the board and write the correct French translation. Then, they pass the baton to the next player, who gets a new word.
- **Objective:** This adds a physical and competitive element, making learning more dynamic.



20 Questions (French Version)

- **How to Play:** One student thinks of an object, place, or person (all related to daily French vocabulary). The other students can ask up to 20 yes-or-no questions in French to figure out what it is. For example, if the object is voiture (car), questions could include: Est-ce que c'est un objet? (Is it an object?), Est-ce que c'est grand? (Is it big?).
- **Objective:** This game encourages students to think in French and form simple sentences.
