- Fluency

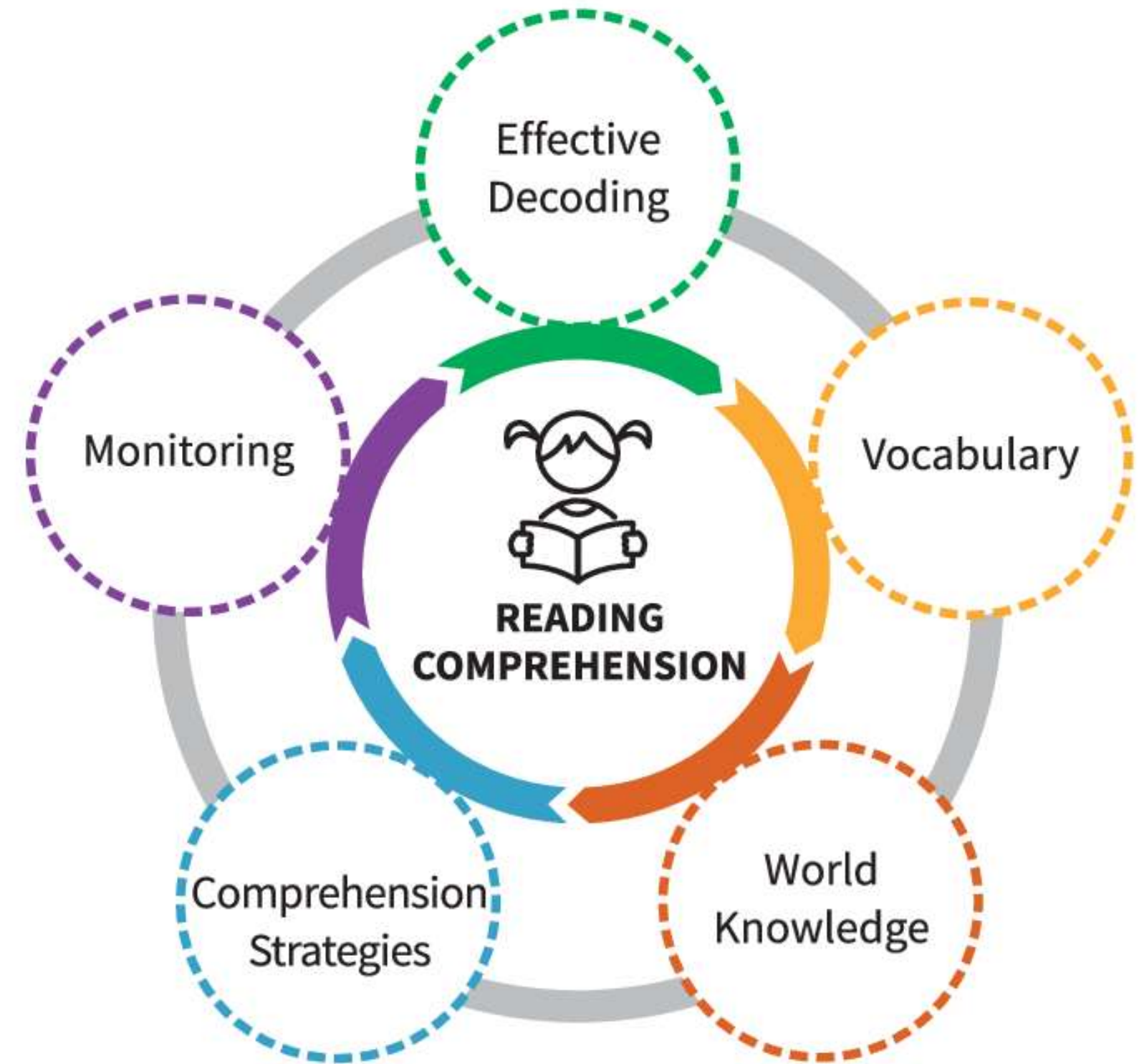




What is Reading Comprehension?



Reading comprehension completes an individual's skill to read. Because this means that an individual is able to understand the meaning of the text correctly.





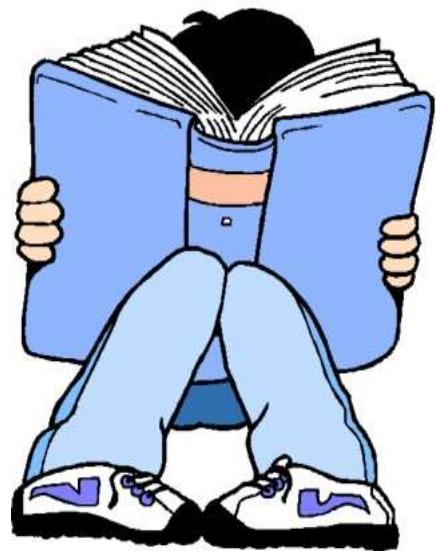
Types of Reading Techniques

And mostly requires a teacher-led classroom for these age groups.

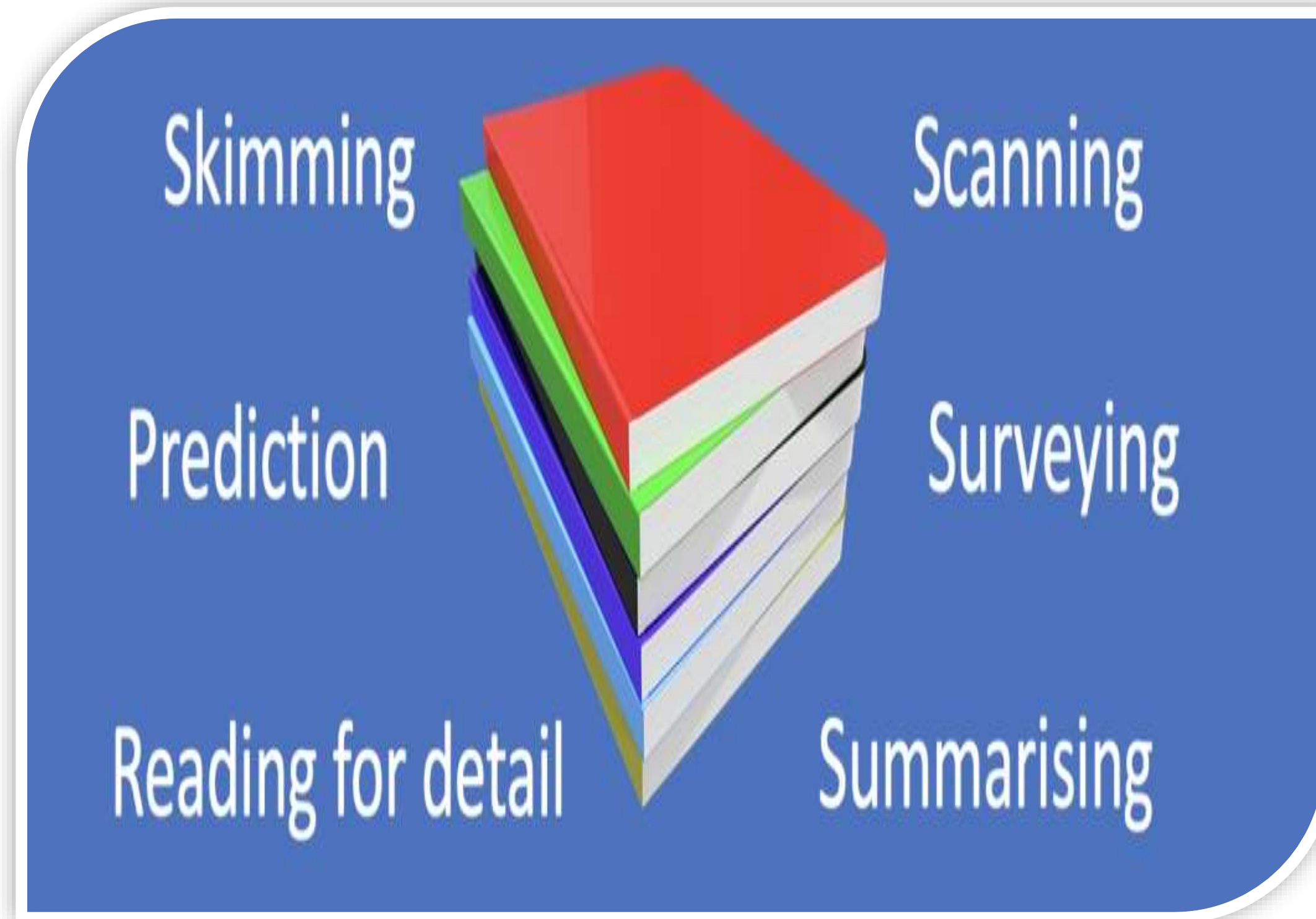
Extensive– It aims at creating a broader understanding of the written text, mostly for educational purposes only.
